- 2 x aft symmetrical cabins with: One double bed on each, stowage beneath double bed, lockers, shelf along hull, halogen lights (5/6-cabin version)
- 1 cabin (between saloon and aft cabins) with 2 single beds, lockers, and halogen lights.
- 6 x heads (one in each cabin) with: marine toilet with manual pump (ITT), electric shower drain pump (ITT), wash basin with hot/cold water mixer tap, locker, mirror
- Bulkheads are hand fixed with laminate to the hull and deck
- Interior: For a more traditional feel to yacht we offer Teak, maple or Cherry with Teak and Holly cabin sole. Furniture and bulkheads are made from the finest timber veneers, bonded to high quality marine plies and then finished with solid wood capping and trims. Final finish may be satin or gloss to customer's taste.
- Saloon seats with fixed table for 12 persons
- Dedicated chart table with shelves, locker, electric panel with switches, water tank, holding tank and battery indicators and pre-installation for generator/air conditioning switches

### **Owners Version**

The OWNERS version yacht is similar to the CHARTER version with the exception of the cabin layout. The differences are as follows:

***Owner's cabin (5 cabin version):*** This is a luxurious Master Cabin situated aft of the dinette with seats, large stowage lockers and en-suite heads compartment.

***Owner's cabin (4 cabin version):*** There are two luxurious Master Cabins, situated one aft of the dinette and one forward.

***Skipper's cabin:*** The Skippers Cabin occupies the bow of the yacht, is much longer compared to the Charter Version and also has an en-suite heads compartment.
